May 16, 2025 FirstRand Group Explores Strategic Collaboration with GIFT IFI



May 24, 2025 Fintech Foundation Course: Batch Two Begins


A new cohort with diverse backgrounds has begun their journey at the Fintech Foundation course at GIFT International Fintech Institute.


A 6-day immersive program covering digital finance, blockchain, and more.

These efforts are in close synergy with the educational programs of GIFT IFI, ensuring a seamless pipeline from talent development to real-world innovation.



April 7-9, 2025 Event Spotlight: GIFT IFIH Innovation Expo

From April 7-9, GIFT IFIH proudly hosted its inaugural Innovation Expo, drawing over 200 attendees for an exciting three-day event that celebrated the achievements of Batch 0 startups. This landmark occasion provided these emerging innovators with a platform to pitch their groundbreaking solutions while fostering valuable connections with industry leaders, regulators, and investors.

1. Founders' Brunch: Sharing Entrepreneurial Insights

The Expo kicked off with an inspiring Founders' Brunch, where entrepreneurs shared their personal stories of resilience and success. The session also featured a dynamic VC reverse pitch, giving startups an exclusive opportunity to understand investor expectations and refine their pitch for future funding opportunities.

2. Corporate Innovation Series: Collaboration at the Core

The Corporate Innovation Series offered attendees a series of insightful workshops, as well as a panel discussion on "GIFT City as a Catalyst for Innovation in Financial Services." The session emphasized the importance of corporate-startup collaboration and showcased how GIFT City is positioning itself as a key player in transforming the financial services sector.

3. Open House: Thought Leadership from Industry Experts

The Expo concluded with an impactful Open House session, featuring keynote addresses from distinguished dignitaries including Ms. Mona Khandhar, Principal Secretary, Science and Technology, Government of Gujarat; Mr. Tapan Ray, Managing Director and Group CEO of GIFT City; and Dr. Hasmukh Adhia, Chairman of GIFT City.



May 16, 2025 Workshop on the Strategic Adoption of Al in Financial Services

On 16 May 2025, Gujarat International Finance Tec-City Company Limited (GIFTCL) in partnership with The Coalition for Responsible Evolution of AI (CoRE-AI) convened a highlevel, in-person workshop focused on the strategic and responsible adoption of artificial intelligence (AI) in the financial services sector.

Held at GIFT IFIH, this workshop brought together leading stakeholders from across the financial services ecosystem. Participants included senior executives from retail and corporate banking, investment banking, insurance, asset and wealth management, NBFCs, fintech companies, and AI technology providers.

Residential Program: Now Live

In May 2025, GIFT IFIH launched a 6-month Residential Program focused on solutions across Fintech, Data, and AI, tailored for the BFSI (Banking, Financial Services, and Insurance) industry. Hosted at GIFT City, this hybrid incubation program combines in-residence collaboration, global mentorship, and investment-readiness support to assist startups at various stages of development.

The program is structured in two phases:

1. Phase 1 (First 3 months):


Focuses on transforming early-stage ideas into a Minimum Viable Product (MVP), with hands-on support and resources available within the GIFT City ecosystem.

2.) Phase 2 (Final 3 months):

Dedicated to validating the MVP and achieving Product Market Fit (PMF), with continued mentorship and investor access.

To connect with the broader startup community, GIFT IFIH organized four roadshows—three offline events in GIFT City, Bangalore, and Hyderabad, and one online session. These events provided an opportunity for startups to learn more about the program and engage directly with the initiative.

June 2025 New Startup Initiative: The Always On Program

In June 2025, GIFT IFIH introduced the Always On Program, a rolling accelerator designed for high-potential fintech startups from post-seed to Series D. The program provides:

1. Strategic Connections:

Expert advisory and pitch review support to refine fundraising efforts.


3. Visibility & Showcase:
